Copperstate Fly-In & Education Expo

An estimated 500 aircraft will be on display at the Copperstate Fly-In & Education Expo to be held Friday & Saturday, October 28-29 at Mesa's Falcon Field Airport, 4800 E. Falcon Drive.

Bringing together aviation enthusiasts in the Southwest since 1973, it is the largest fly-in of its type in the western United States. Participating aircraft include ultralights, light sport, gyrocopters, home-built (experimental) aircraft, antiques, vintage, warbirds and general aviation aircraft. The public can walk among the aircraft during the event.

A variety of activities are planned for pilots and the public to provide an educational experience that will enhance knowledge and skills. Offerings will include educational workshops, pilot forums, aircraft rides, aircraft and product exhibits, youth education activities, aviation career information, drone education, exhibit flying and food.

Overnight tent camping and parking for motor homes is available, including shower facilities. Gates open at 8 a.m. and close at 4 p.m. each day. Admission is \$12 to \$15 per day. Admission is free to ages 18 and under.

Report Graffiti with City Smartphone App

The City of Mesa is dedicated to keeping our community clean and safe, including striving to make the City graffiti-free. Residents can help the City's graffiti abatement team by reporting graffiti through the free smartphone app, Mesa CityLink. The app guides users step-by-step to take a photo of the graffiti and submit it. Using the smartphone's built-in GPS, the app automatically collects the location of the request to enable Mesa's graffiti abatement team to be dispatched to the exact location. Once reported, graffiti will be removed within 24 hours on City business days; a standby dispatch crew is on-call during weekends and holidays for offensive graffiti to be removed as quickly as possible. Residents may also call the graffiti hotline at **480-644-3083** to make a report.

Garbage Truck Safety

Your City of Mesa garbage truck visits your neighborhood twice a week, 52 weeks a year. Keep yourself and your loved ones safe by remembering three simple things. When you see a City of Mesa garbage truck driving down your street, make sure you STOP so you don't get in the way. You can WATCH the truck empty your barrel from a safe distance (at least 25' away) but whatever you do, be safe and STAY AWAY.

Bag & Tie Your Trash

County and local ordinances require that you seal any garbage that can cause unsanitary conditions and the breeding of flies. Examples of the types of waste that need to be "bagged and tied" when placed into the BLACK trash barrel include:

- Food waste and food-coated containers
- Yard waste such as grass and leaves
- Diapers
- General bathroom waste
- Pet waste
